

## RINGING ON HOLT ISLAND ON 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023

The weather was cold, overcast but calm. The aim of this short session was to catch warblers which was successful. Two of the Reed Warblers were ringed at Holt Island one in June 2020 and the other in July 2022.

There were good numbers of singing birds including all the species caught along with Garden Warbler, Great Tits and Blue Tits. During the morning several Swift were seen and heard high over the Island. A number of Common Terns were seen along the river.

In spite of the cold a Peacock Butterfly and a Holly Blue were seen.
